Document of Understanding

Document Intent:

Section 75(e) of the Illinois Firearm Concealed Carry Act has been outlined within this document. The Intent of this section is to provide approved instructors authority to determine whether the student has performed to the standards required within this Act. This includes ensuring the student is performing in an appropriate and safe manner, as well as meeting the minimum standards for range qualification. If the instructor determines the student is not adhering to the conditions outlined below, the instructor has the authority to deny certification.

Students Responsibilities:

This document must be reviewed and signed by each student prior to admittance into the State of Illinois approved Concealed Carry course offered by Wright Firearms Training. Any student who fails to review and/or sign this statement will not be allowed admittance into this course.

(430 ILCS 66/75 (e))

A certification of completion for an applicant's firearm training course shall not be issued to a student who:

1. Does not follow the orders of the certified firearms instructor;
2. In the judgement of the certified instructor, handles a firearm in a manner that poses a danger to the student or to others; or
3. During the range firing portion of the testing fails to hit the target with 70% of the rounds fired.
